



Boy Scout Workshops & Programs Fall-Winter 2010

Wesselman Nature Society hosts workshops for Boy Scouts of all age levels within its programs and properties: Wesselman Woods Nature Preserve, Howell Wetlands, and Canoe Evansville. Boys will experience the wonders of nature through hands-on discovery activities, trail exploration, animal encounters, games, crafts, and more in our woods, wetlands, and waterways.

Workshop activities are selected to meet badge, achievement, or elective requirements in a fun, unique way. Please note the following:

- Workshops cover all requirements to complete one or a combination of badges, achievements, or electives. (*The Webelos Outdoorsman workshop will cover many, but not all requirements due to time constraints.*)
- Workshop activities may not be exactly as outlined in the handbook. Some substitution may occur due to weather, time constraints, and resources available.
- WNS does not provide bead, badge, or pin awards.
- Troops should arrive 15 minutes early for their program.
- A ratio of 1 adult leader for every 6 boys is required.
- Boys should come dressed for the weather, as some activities are outdoors. In the case of inclement weather, indoor activities may be substituted.
- Daytime workshops do not include meals or snacks. Scouts may brown bag lunch if participating in full day or multiple workshops.
