



Girl Scout Workshops & Programs Fall-Winter 2010

Wesselman Nature Society hosts workshops for Girl Scouts of all age levels within its programs and properties: Wesselman Woods Nature Preserve, Howell Wetlands, and Canoe Evansville. Girls will experience the wonders of nature through hands-on discovery activities, trail exploration, animal encounters, games, crafts, and more in our woods, wetlands, and waterways.

Weekend and evening workshops are offered. Workshop activities are selected to meet badge requirements in a fun, unique way. Please note the following:

- Workshops cover all requirements to complete one or more badges. (*not always guaranteed in Teen GS workshops*)
- Workshop activities may not be exactly as outlined in the handbook. Some substitution may occur due to weather, time constraints, and resources available.
- WNS provides badges and try-Its upon completion of the program (except for Daisies).
- Troops should arrive 15 minutes early for their program.
- A ratio of one adult leader for every six girls is required.
- Girls should come dressed for the weather, as some activities are outdoors. In the case of inclement weather, indoor activities may be substituted.
- Daytime workshops do not include meals or snacks. Scouts may brown bag lunch if staying for multiple workshops. Evening & overnight workshops include hot dogs and s'mores over a campfire and drinks, but girls are advised to eat dinner before arriving.
